








#### Cutting

Refer to Figure 1 for diamond cutting detail.






#### Fabric A, cut:

(1) 4%" x WOF (11.12cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 4%" (11.12cm) squares and (4) 4" (10.16cm) squares

(1) 31/4" x WOF (8.26cm x WOF); sub-cut (8) 21/2" x 31/4" (6.35cm x 8.26cm)

(3) 21/8" x WOF (5.39cm x WOF); sub-cut (16) 21/8" (5.39cm) squares and (16) 21/8" (5.39cm) diamonds

#### Fabrics B, cut:

(1) 31/4" x WOF (8.26cm x WOF); sub-cut (12) 21/2" x 31/4" (6.35cm x 8.26cm)

(4) 21/8" x WOF (5.39cm x WOF); sub-cut (24) 21/8" (5.39cm) squares and (24) 21/8" (5.39cm) diamonds

#### Fabric C, cut:

(1) 4%" x WOF (11.12cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 4%" (11.12cm) squares and (4) 4" (10.16cm) squares

(1) 31/4" x WOF (8.26cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 21/2" x 31/4" (6.35cm x 8.26cm)

(2) 21/8" x WOF (5.39cm x WOF); sub-cut (8) 21/8" (5.39cm) squares and (8) 21/8" (5.39cm) diamonds

#### Fabric D, cut:

(1) 31/4" x WOF (8.26cm x WOF); sub-cut (8) 21/2" x 31/4" (6.35cm x 8.26cm) and (1) 31/4" (8.26cm) square

(4) 21/8" x WOF (5.39cm x WOF); sub-cut (24) 21/8" (5.39cm) squares and (24) 21/8" (5.39cm) diamonds

#### Fabric E, cut:

enough 2½" (6.35cm) bias strips to make 298" (756.92cm) of finished bias binding

#### Fabrics F. H. I. R. S. T. U. V. W. cut from each:

Trace Piece 3 units (template on page 11) to the wrong side of the fabric and cut out. Cut (4) of each left-facing and (4) of each right facing (turn the template over).

#### Fabric G, cut:

(1) 4%" x WOF (11.12cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 4%" (11.12cm) squares and (4) 4" (10.16cm) squares

#### Fabric J, cut:

(1) 4%" x WOF (11.12cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 4%" (11.12cm) squares and (4) 4" (10.16cm) squares

(1) 3¼" x WOF (8.26cm x WOF); sub-cut (3) 3¼" (8.26cm) squares

(1) 2\%" x WOF (7.3cm x WOF); sub-cut (6) 2\%" (7.30cm) squares and cut once diagonally to make (12) Piece 5 triangles

(2) 2½" x WOF (6.35cm x WOF); sub-cut (24) 2½" (6.35cm) squares

#### Fabric K, cut:

(1) 4%" x WOF (11.12cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 4%" (11.12cm) squares and (4) 4" (10.16cm) squares

(1) 31/4" x WOF (8.26cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 21/2" x 31/4" (6.35cm x 8.26cm) and (1) 31/4" (8.26cm) square

(1) 2\%" x WOF (7.3cm x WOF); sub-cut (2) 2\%" (7.30cm) squares and cut once diagonally to make (4) Piece 5 triangles

(1) 2½" x WOF (6.35cm x WOF); sub-cut (16) 2½" (6.35cm) squares





#### Fabric L, cut:

- (1) 31/4" x WOF (8.26cm x WOF); sub-cut (3) 31/4" (8.26cm) squares
- (1) 2\%" x WOF (7.30cm x WOF); sub-cut (6) 2\%" (7.30cm) squares and cut once diagonally to make (12) Piece 5 triangles
- (2) 21/2" x WOF (6.35cm x WOF); sub-cut (24) 21/2" (6.35cm) squares

#### Fabric M, cut:

- (1) 4%" x WOF (11.12cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 4%" (11.12cm) squares and (4) 4" (10.16cm) squares
- (1) 31/4" x WOF (8.26cm x WOF); sub-cut (1) 31/4" (8.26cm) square
- (1) 2\%" x WOF (7.30cm x WOF); sub-cut (2) 2\%" (7.30cm) squares and cut each once diagonally to make (4) Piece 5 triangles
- (1) 2½" x WOF (6.35cm x WOF); sub-cut (8) 2½" (6.35cm) squares

#### Fabrics N and P, cut from each:

- (1) 4%" x WOF (11.12cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 4%" (11.12cm) squares and (4) 4" (10.16cm) squares
- (1) 4" x WOF (10.16cm x WOF); sub-cut (6) 4" (10.16cm) squares and cut twice diagonally to make (24) Piece 4 triangles
- (2) 21/2" x WOF (6.35cm x WOF); sub-cut (24) 21/2" (6.35cm) squares

#### Fabric O, cut:

(1) 4%" x WOF (11.12cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 4%" (11.12cm) squares and (4) 4" (10.16cm) squares

- (1) 4" x WOF (10.16cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 4" (10.16cm) squares and cut twice diagonally to make (16) Piece 4 triangles
- (1) 21/2" x WOF (6.35cm x WOF); sub-cut (16) 21/2" (6.35cm) squares

#### Fabric Q, cut:

- (1) 2½" x WOF (6.35cm x WOF); sub-cut (8) 2½" (6.35cm) squares
- (1) 4" x WOF (10.16cm x WOF); sub-cut (2) 4" (10.16cm) squares and cut twice diagonally to make (8) Piece 4 triangles

#### Fabrics S1 – S9, cut from each:

- (1) 111/8" x WOF (28.26cm x WOF); sub-cut (1) 111/8" (28.26cm) square and cut twice diagonally to make (4) Piece 2 triangles; and (4) 4%" (11.12cm) squares and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square
- (1) 4" x WOF (10.16cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 4" (10.16cm) squares
- (2) 2½" x WOF (6.35cm x 6.35cm x WOF); sub-cut (24) 2½" (6.35cm) squares and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (16) squares. Cut (8) squares once diagonally to make (16) Piece 1 half-square triangles (HST).

### Sewing

All seam allowances are 1/4" (.64cm) and pieces are sewn right sides together. Instructions are for piecing Block 1. Refer to the chart with Step 11 for Block 2-9 fabric requirements

### **Block Assembly**

#### Quarter-star Units

**1.** Place a 43/8" (11.12cm) **Fabric S8** square, right sides together with a 4%" (11.12cm) Fabric P square. Sew 1/4" (.635cm) on each side of the marked line. Cut the unit in half on the drawn line. Make a total of (8) matching HST that measure 4" (10.16cm) square (Fig.

2. Arrange (2) HST, (1) 4" (10.16cm) Fabric P square, and (1) 4" (10.16cm) Fabric S8 square as shown. Sew together to complete a 7½" (19.05cm) unit (Fig. 3). Make a total of (4) units.

#### **Feather Units**

- 3. Place a 2½" (6.35cm) **Fabric S8** square right sides together with a 2½" (6.35cm) Fabric P square. Sew 1/4" (.64cm) on each side of the marked line. Cut the unit in half on the drawn line (Fig. 4). Make (16) matching HST units that measure 21/8" (5.39cm) square.
- **4.** Place a 2½" (6.35cm) **Fabric S8** square right sides together with a 21/2" (6.35cm) Fabric L square. Sew 1/4" (.64cm) on each side of the marked line. Cut the unit in half on the drawn line. Make (16) matching HST units that measure 21/8" (5.39cm) square.







#### **Corner Unit**

5. Arrange a unit created in Step 2 above, (1) 21/8" (5.39cm) Fabric A square, (2) Fabric A diamonds, (2) Piece 1 Fabric 58 HST, (2) HST units created in Step 3, and (2) HST units created in Step 4. Sew these pieces together to complete the corner unit (Fig. 5). Make a total of (4) corner units.




Corner Unit Make 4


#### **Side Units**

6. Arrange a Piece 2 Fabric S8 triangle, (1) 21/4" (5.39cm) Fabric A square, (2) Piece 1 Fabric S8 HST, (2) HST units created in Step 3, and (2) HST units created in Step 4. Sew these pieces together using partial seams when sewing to the Piece 2 triangle (Fig. 6). Make a total of (4) units.






7. Complete the side units with (2) Piece 3 Fabric H and (1) Piece 4 Fabric P triangles (Fig. 7).



#### **Center Unit**

8. To make the center unit arrange (1) 3½" (8.26cm) Fabric L square, (4) 2½" x 3½" (6.35cm x 825cm) Fabric A rectangles, and (4) Piece 4 Fabric P Triangles as shown. Sew the units into rows, then sew the rows together. Complete the Center Unit with (4) Piece 5 Fabric L Triangles (Fig. 8).




Center Unit

#### **Feathered Star Block**

**9.** Arrange a side unit and (2) corner units as shown in Figure 8. Sew together, then complete the partial seam. Make (2) units (Fig. 9).

#### Make 2

10. Arrange the block center with the (2) remaining side units and the sections created in Step 9 above. Sew the units to the block center, then sew the rows together to complete the block, completing the partial seams (Fig. 10 on page 8).

#### Blocks 2 - 9

11. Repeat Steps 1-10 using the fabrics listed in the chart on page 8 to make Blocks 2-9.






### **Quilt Top Assembly**

- 12. Following the Quilt Layout diagram on page 9 for placement and orientation, lay out the blocks in (3) rows of (3) blocks each.
- 13. Sew together the blocks in each row, pressing seams in alternate directions for adjacent rows. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt top.


## Finishing

- 14. Sew together the 2½" (6.35cm) Fabric E binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- 15. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and guilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
- 16. Leaving an 8" (20.32cm) tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" (30.48cm) from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along guilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" (.64cm) and press open. Finish sewing binding to
- 17. Turn the binding to the back of guilt and hand-stitch in place.


